State licensed and a “**Paths to Quality**” provider, the age-appropriate curriculum spans a wide range. Activities selected for this group help to promote Gross motor and Fine motor skills as well as Social skills. **Full- time only.**



Summer Camp: Ages 3-12

Each week is loaded with fun, along with field trips that will ensure your child/children have an enjoyable and memorable summer for the months of June and July.

Pre-School / Pre-K

Curriculum based and developmentally appropriate instruction is divided into 2 classrooms; 3-4 year olds and Pre- Kindergarten. Classes begin in August and run through the month of May following the Flat Rock-Hawcreek Corporation Calendar. Class schedules are from 8:30am to 11:00am. Spots in this program can be full-time (which is encouraged), or part-time.



Before/After School:

We follow the FRHC school calendar. Monday thru Friday dismissal – 6:00pm at the Elementary School. Students receive academic assistance, nutritional snack and exercise.



Extended Day Hours/ Emergency Care:

We offer before (7:00am – 8:00am) and after (4:00pm – 5:30pm) preschool hours. A “Quiet Time” from 12:00pm -2:00pm is a part of this routine also. Emergency drop-in service can be available, call our office for more details.
