## History

Su Casa Columbus was founded in 1999 as a response to the increase of Latin American immigrants arriving to Columbus. The majority of these immigrants had limited English proficiency. Su Casa was established to provide a helping hand and remove barriers to make essential services in our community accessible for those families.

Su Casa Columbus is set to serve as a catalyst to facilitate the interaction of the Latino community within Bartholomew County and surrounding areas to help them become more self-sufficient in a shorter period of time.

- Economic independence
